Dr. Helmut Többen joined the German Aerospace Center (DLR) in 1994.

There Dr. Többen currently heads the Management Services department of the Institute of Flight Guidance.

The Management Services perform the central administrative and strategic tasks of the Institute. This includes, in particular, quality and IT management, public relations, human resources management, financial controlling, as well as marketing and project acquisition for all areas of the Institute.

At the same time Dr. Többen acts as a director of the AT-One EEIG, the strategic alliance between DLR and the Royal Netherlands Aerospace Centre (NLR). AT-One is a member of SESAR 2020.

Before this he was a business manager responsible for raising national and international third-party funds while also pursuing cooperation projects in the areas of on-board ATM, human factors and training at the DLR Institute.

Dr. Többen graduated with a degree in physics from the Technical University Hannover. He obtained his doctorate in electrical engineering from the Technical University in Braunschweig as holder of a DLR scholarship with fundamental research regarding the accuracy of laser gyros.
