Stéphane graduated from École Polytechnique (France), and holds a PhD in theoretical physics. As a military engineer, Stéphane was seconded by French defense procurement agency DGA to Snecma from 1998 to 2001 to work on advanced materials. He then returned to DGA in 2001, where he occupied various roles in the field of aircraft propulsion until 2004, and was in charge of the industrial strategy for Missiles and Space from 2005 to 2008.

Stéphane joined Safran in 2008. He was appointed General Manager of the Turbine Airfoils Center of Excellence of Safran Aircraft Engines in Gennevilliers in 2010, then Managing Director of Aircelle Ltd, the British subsidiary of Safran Nacelles, in 2013.

Moving back to France, Stéphane took the responsibility of Managing Director of Safran Tech, Safran's new corporate R&T center, headquartered in Paris-Saclay, in January 2015. He was appointed SEVP and CTO of Safran, in charge of Research, Technology & Innovation, and joined the Executive Committee of Safran in July 2016.
