Joseph McGinley was appointed as Head of Investor Relations of AerCap in December 2017. AerCap listed on the NYSE with the ticker AER in 2006, and has grown since then to be the largest aircraft leasing company in the world with over \$45bn of assets. In this role, he has primary responsibility for all external communication with credit and equity investors.

In addition to investor communications, Mr. McGinley also has responsibility for the Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) strategy research and delivery for AerCap. This involves interacting with the main ESG rating agency providers as well as the sustainability and governance officers of various investment houses.

He previously served as a Senior Credit Analyst with Davy Capital Markets in Dublin where he led the credit coverage of the aircraft leasing, airline, utility, building materials and renewables sectors. In addition, he previously worked in various roles in wealth management and banking. With almost 13 years' experience, Joseph has extensive knowledge in financial markets and the aviation sector, with an added focus on sustainability.

Joseph holds a Bachelor and Business and & Law (BBLS) degree from University College Dublin, a Diploma in Aircraft Leasing and Finance from the Law Society of Ireland, and has been a CFA® charterholder since 2013.
