



## **Prof. Sergey L. Chernyshev**

Born on May 15, 1955.

Chair of the International Forum for Aviation Research (IFAR), Chief Scientific Officer of Central AeroHydrodynamic Institute named after Professor N.E. Zhukovsky (TsAGI), PhD, professor, academician of the Russian Academy of Science. He graduated from the Moscow Institute of Physics & Technology (PhysTech) with honors and received his M.S. Degree (1978), PhD (1981) at Moscow PhysTech (1981) and Senior Doctorate Degree (Physics & Mathematics) at TsAGI (2005). In 2016 he was elected as Academician of the

Russian Academy of Sciences.

Prof. Chernyshev is a world recognized expert in aircraft aerodynamics, CFD, as well as aircraft concept design & integration. He has been working at TsAGI for over 40 years at different research and management positions, recently as General Director of TsAGI, since August 2018 as Chief Scientific Officer of TsAGI. Also since 2019 he works as Deputy General Director for International Cooperation of The National Research Center “Zhukovsky Institute” (NRC).

He is a professor at the Moscow Institute of Physics & Technology and Chairman of its Flight Physics Department.

Dr. Chernyshev is Chair of IFAR (since 2019), the world’s only aviation research establishment network. He is an Associate Fellow of AIAA, Member of the ICAS Executive Committee. In the mid-90s he worked in the United States as a Director of the TsAGI field office and contributed to expanding technical scientific cooperation between Russian and US, along with other Western countries.

Prof. Chernyshev received several National awards from the Russian Government and international awards among which is the “Aviation Week & Space Technology Laurels Award” for significant contributions to Global Aerospace (2001), the French National Order of Merit (2012), ICAS – Daniel and Florence Guggenheim Award (2014).
